# **DRIVER'S LICENCE**

# **FAQ**

**Q.** What are the requirements for obtaining a Provisional Driver's Licence (Learners Licence)?

#### A.

- 2 Passport sized photos certified by; Justice of the peace (JP), Minister of Religion, Police Officer, rank of superintendent or higher
- Visit any Tax Office & present a TRN
- Complete Application form
- Pay applicable fee

NB\* Applicant must be able to read and write in English.

**Q.** What are the requirements for obtaining a Jamaican Driver's licence?

# Α.

- Obtain a Provisional Driver's Licence (Learner's Licence)
- Complete a General or Private Licence form (forms can be obtain in office or downloaded from TAJs website) <u>hyperlink</u>
- Purchase an Examination fee ONLINE <u>www.jamaicatax.gov.jm</u> (hyperlink) or at any Tax
  Office
- Take the completed form along with three certified Passport sized photographs to the Island Traffic Authority (ITA) (Depot)
- Upon successfully completing the Written and Road tests a date will be given to visit the Tax Office to collect the driver's licence.
- At Tax Office:
  - 1. Complete Driver's Licence Driver's Licence form (Form F7) hyperlink
  - 2. Pay applicable fee

**Q.** If I am a holder of a valid overseas driver's licence and I wish to obtain a Jamaican driver's licence, what should I do?

A.

- Overseas licence should be current, this will negate the need to obtain a Provisional Driver's Licence (Learner's Licence)
- Complete a General or Private Licence form (forms can be obtain in office or downloaded from TAJs website)
- Purchase an Examination fee at any Tax Office
- Take the completed form along with three certified Passport sized photographs to the Island Traffic Authority (ITA) (Depot)
- Upon successfully completing the Written and Road tests a date will be given to visit the Tax Office to collect the driver's licence.
- At Tax Office:
  - 3. Complete Driver's Licence Driver's Licence form (form F7)
  - 4. Pay applicable fee
- **Q.** What is the minimum age for applying for a Provisional Driver's Licence?
- A. 17 years old
- Q. What is the minimum age for applying for a Driver's Licence?
- A. 17 years 6 months old pending Road Traffic Act
- **Q.** What is the minimum age for receiving a PPV Licence?
- A. 21 years old
- **Q.** What is the minimum age for receiving an International Driver's licence?
- A. 17 years 6 months old pending Road Traffic Act
- **Q.** How long is the Jamaican driver's licence valid for?
- **A.** 5 Birthdays
- Q. How long is the International Permit valid for?
- **A.** The International Permit is valid for 1 year. However, in the case where the local driver's licence has less than a year, the permit will expire on the same date as the local drivers licence.

Q. How do I upgrade my driver's licence?

# Α.

- Purchase an Examination fee at any Tax Office
- Take three certified Passport sized photographs to the Island Traffic Authority (ITA)
  (Depot)
- Upon successfully completing the Written and Road tests, a date will be given to visit the Tax Office to collect the driver's licence.
- At Tax Office:
  - 5. Complete Driver's Licence Driver's Licence form (form F7) hyperlink
  - 6. Pay applicable fee

Q. How do I update my driver's licence to reflect my married name?

## Α.

- Take the following documents to any tax office to have your name updated to reflect the married name:
  - 1. Marriage certificate
  - 2. Valid ID (Passport, D/Licence, National ID)
  - 3. Completed Supplemental form
- Complete Driver's Licence Application form (F7)
- Pay Applicable fee

NB \* Driver's Licence update can take place after 3 working days following the name update.

Q. What is the process for applying for a LOST driver's licence?

## A.

- Visit any Tax Office, with 1 certified photograph
- Completed substitute application form & driver's licence application form (F7) hyperlink
- Pay applicable fee(s)

- **Q.** Can a driver's licence renewal be done on behalf of the holder?
- **A**. Yes, accompanied with the following:
  - Completed application form (F7) hyperlink signed by Notary Public, Consulate, Justice of the Peace (JP) or any authorized body.
  - Letter of authorization signed by Notary Public, Consulate, Justice of the Peace (JP) or any authorized body.
  - Passport sized photo signed by Notary Public, Consulate, Justice of the Peace (JP) or any authorized body.
  - Valid ID is required for the bearer
  - Pay applicable fee
- **Q.** Can an International Licence application /Renewal be done on behalf of the Driver's Licence holder?
- **A**. Yes, accompanied with the following:
  - Completed International Driver's Licence form signed by Notary Public, Consulate, Justice of the Peace (JP) or any authorized body.
  - Jamaican driver's licence (original)
  - Letter of authorization signed by Notary Public, Consulate, Justice of the Peace (JP) or any authorized body.
  - Passport sized photo signed by Notary Public, Consulate, Justice of the Peace (JP) or any authorized body.
  - Valid ID is required for the bearer
  - NO fee applicable
